STATEMENT OF POLICY - 5

SUBJECT: Membership Status

WHEREAS the By-laws of the State Engineering Association, Article 1, Section 2 (c) provides for a determination by the Board of Directors relative to the dues-paying procedure; and,

WHEREAS Article 1, Section 4 (a) of the By-laws of the State Engineering Association states that members' rights cease upon failure to pay required dues or assessments when due; BE IT THEREFORE

RESOLVED that the monies of members received by the Association via dues checkoff shall be applied to the member's account and considered current dues for the period during which the members earned the monies; and be it further

RESOLVED that the monies of members received by the Association via cash or check shall be applied to the members account and considered as current dues for the period stated or implied by the members at the time of such payment by cash or check.

Be it finally RESOLVED that no member shall be considered delinquent if:

- 1) the member's name appears on the latest dues checkoff list submitted to the Association Treasurer by the State of Wisconsin; or
- 2) if on a cash basis, the member's dues are paid to within thirty (30) calendar days of the specific date in question.\*
