STATEMENT OF POLICY - 6

SUBJECT: Liaison with the Wisconsin Society of Professional Engineers

WHEREAS the objectives of the Association include promoting the engineering profession, high standards and a cooperative spirit among its members; and,

WHEREAS the membership of the Association has heretofore made known its desire for cooperation with the Wisconsin Society of Professional Engineers in the attainment of mutual objectives; and,

WHEREAS the Wisconsin Society of Professional Engineers has on June 23, 1972, authorized liaison with the State Engineering Association, BE IT THEREFORE

RESOLVED that it is the policy of the state Engineering Association to establish liaison with the Wisconsin Society of Professional Engineers for the purpose of promoting the engineering profession and the interests of those engaged therein; AND BE IT FURTHER

RESOLVED that such liaison shall include bilateral development and participation in the following areas of common interest: registration of engineers and certification of technicians; programs in the areas of legislation, public relations, education, professional development, ethics, and civic activities benefiting the engineering profession and the public welfare; and such other areas of common interest which may be appropriate, excepting and expressly prohibiting active participation by the Society in any collective bargaining matters; and BE IT FINALLY

RESOLVED that a permanent standing committee, consisting of at least one Board Member and remaining in all instances responsible to the Association Board of Directors, shall be appointed for the purpose of conducting said liaison.
